

What you need:

- 2.75m x 2 pieces (5.5m total) 140-150cm (54-60") wide outdoor fabric
- 28 of 11mm (7/16") grommets
- 20m of 6.3mm (1/4") cotton or nylon rope
- 2 x 5cm (2") O-rings



1. Fold 7cm (2.5") of both ends of fabric pieces to the **WRONG** side and press.



2. With **RIGHT** sides together, match sides, pin and stitch together. Turn **RIGHT** side out and press edges.



3. Topstitch along edge of seam.



4. Match folded edges at the top and bottom, pin and edgestitch closed.



5. Topstitch along top and bottom edges at both 1.5cm (5/8") and 5cm (2") to reinforce for grommet placement.



6. Starting 2.5cm (1") from each side, mark the position of each grommet (approx 10cm / 4") apart for 14 grommets total along both top and bottom.



7. Following instructions on the grommet package, set grommets where marked.

8. Knot one end of a rope length and thread unknotted end through the underside of the first grommet, through an O ring, leaving approximately 70cm (28") between the O ring and the grommet. Thread rope through the next top of the next grommet and then through the underside of the 3rd grommet. Repeat pattern until all grommets have been threaded and knot the rope on the underside of the final grommet. (repeat on other end).

OPTIONAL: wrap additional rope around all rope lengths just below the O ring and secure.
