

Cushion Cover to Knitting Needle Holder

1. Choose a Cushion Cover



1. Most cushions have a zipper at the bottom. Be sure to choose a cushion with a pattern that can be used in either direction or be prepared to remove the bottom zipper and add another to the top.



2. With the zipper at the top and the outside facing up, position the trim approximately 3cm from the bottom edge and fold the ends to the inside. Top stitch top and bottom edges to secure.

3. Fold up bottom edge as little or as much as required to hold your knitting needles (shown 30cm).



4. Cut 1 meter length of ribbon or tape (for ties) and fold to create a 60cm long tie and a 40 cm short tie. Attach to edge of cushion as shown.



5. Edge stitch sides of fold together to create a pocket, then channel stitch 2.5 cm evenly across the folded pocket through all layers.



And you're done!



*Optional - For a finishing touch open the top zipper and add embroidered initial or applique through one layer only.
