Happy Hooded Bath Towel

Keep cozy after bathtime or at the beach with this super easy hooded towel. Use a store-bought towel or make your own and match with fun flannelette prints for a perfect gift for new babies or a cuddly wrap for kids of all ages.




WHAT YOU NEED:

- . bath towel
- . flannelette (approx 40cm x 2 coordinating patterns)
- . basic hood pattern (eg. McCalls M6828)
- . thread

WHAT YOU DO:

1. Pin hood pattern to flannelette and cut 1 hood from both coordinating fabrics.





2. With right sides together, sew centre and side pieces together for each hood. Clip curved seams and press open.





3. With right sides together and matching seams, sew the 2 hoods together along front edge leaving 3cm open at each neck edge. Turn and press.





4. Center outside facing hood neck edge along towel edge with wrong sides together and stitch.



5. Fold under inside facing hood neck edge selvedge, pin and stitch.



And you are Done!
