## What you do:

01

Cut 1 piece each of the wool and the lining 36x12". With right sides together, sew around all edges leaving a small opening.

12"(30.5cm) fold /

14"(36cm)

What you need:
.3m of 150cm boiled wool

fabric (or similar weight)

.3m of lining fabric (any

trim for the strap 2x triangle rings 2x swivel hooks

1.2m faux leather or other

Turn right side out, press flat and edge stitch around the entire rectangle.


Mark 14" on top and bottom edge as diagram and fold as shown.



Fold sides towards the center along top and bottom points and pin. Machine stitch in place as far as possible along edgestitch end as shown. Hand stitch remaining opening to the point.

Fold top of the bag tips over triangle ring bar and stitch in place as shown.

Cut the strap to your preferred length, fold ends over swivel hooks as shown and stitch.





Attach handle and add embellishments such as tassels or appliques to personalize.







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
