

MAKE A RUGGED Leather Cuff BRACELET



Materials

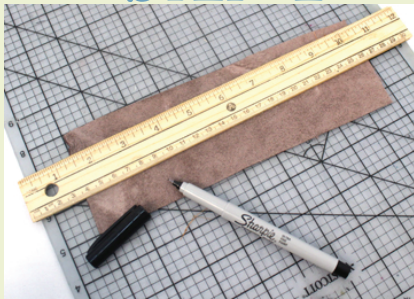
Leather Trim Piece (approx. 3" x 9")
Leather Punch Set
Sew On Snap Fasteners (21mm)
Heavy Duty Household Needles
4"-7" of Fashion Chain

You will also need: Matching thread, scissors, hammer, marker, ruler, thimble (optional)



DIRECTIONS

STEP 1



Use the ruler and marker to measure a 1" leather strip. This will make a 8.5" cuff. For a snug cuff, measure your wrist and add half an inch.

STEP 2



Cut the strip from the trim piece

STEP 3



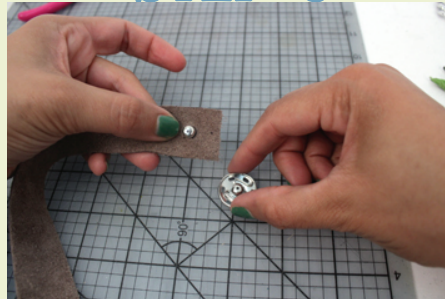
Mark an "X" half an inch from the edge of the leather. This where you'll be making a hole with the leather punch.

STEP 4



Hammer the punch into the leather until a hole is formed. The 6.8mm punch will fit the male side of the snap through it.

STEP 5



Push the male snap through the hole in the leather so it shows on the rough side. Sew the female side of the snap on the other end of the leather piece, on the finished side. Use the leather needle from the Household Needle Set and a thimble, if necessary.

STEP 6



Centre the chain on the leather, and sew the chain on from the centre to start. Add a stitch every couple to links to secure in place.
