DIY Bridal Belt and Sashes can add an individual touch to your special day.

See below for tutorials on three different styles to suit any bride.

Boho Lace Sash

Materials:

Bridal Lace White (1m)
38mm Grosgrain Bridal White (40cm)



Step One:



Make sure to get a piece of lace with 2 full appliques. Cut them carefully apart. Arrange lace appliques so they face away from each other.

Step Two:



Sew lace onto the centre of the ribbon. Finish ribbon edges with a "V" cut, leaving enough to tie into an elegant bow.

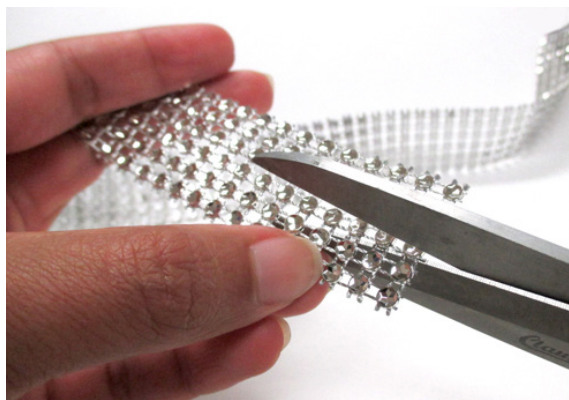
Glam Metallic Belt

Materials:

- 6 Row Bling Ribbon Silver (0.5m)
- 5cm Rhinestone Beaded Brooch
- 38mm Double Faced Satin Silver (1m)



Step One:



Cut the 6 Row Bling Ribbon in half lengthwise to get 2 pieces.

Step Two:



Sew the Bling Ribbon to the centre of the Satin Ribbon. Secure with a stitch to every 4th row of Bling Ribbon.

Step Three:



In the centre of the ribbon attach the brooch.

Step Four:



For extra stability sew through the fabric backing of the brooch. Finish with a "V" cut to the ends of the ribbon.

Classic Rhinestone Sash

Materials:

38mm Double Faced Satin Bridal White (1m)
Layered Center Stitched Lace Trim (.25 m)
6 Row Bling Ribbon Silver (.25m)
9mm x 18mm Horse Eye Jewels
Rhinestone Button

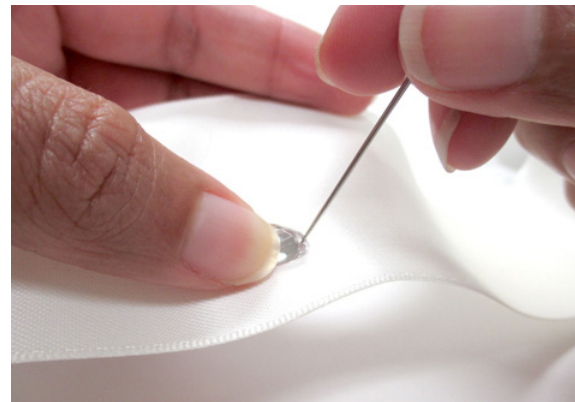


Step One:



Start by lightly tracing out your placement of the jewels in the centre of the ribbon with pencil.

Step Two:



Sew Horse Eye jewels into place.

Step Three:



Cut strips of the Bling ribbon and sew into place between the jewels.

Step Four:



Sew on centre rhinestone button and the organza trim around it. Finish with a "V" cut on the ends of the ribbon.
