

CROCHET MULTIWAY SHAWL



MATERIALS:

- 400g of #4 medium weight yarn
- 6mm(J-10) crochet hook
- Measuring tape
- Ten 19mm buttons
- Tapestry needle

ABBREVIATIONS:

CH = chain
SC = single crochet
DC = double crochet
st(s) = stitch(es)
Rep = repeat

PROJECT SIZE:

Width:
approx. 140cm (55")

Length:
approx. 51cm (20")

PATTERN:

CH 195

Row 1: Starting in the second CH from the hook, SC all sts until the end of the row. (194 STS)

Row 2: CH1, 1 SC in the next 2 sts, * CH2, skip 2 , 1 SC the next 4 sts; Rep from * 4 times. SC all sts until the end of the row.

Row 3: CH1, SC all sts or CH until the end of the row. (The CH's will form your button holes)

Row 4: CH3 (counts as a DC), DC in the next st, *skip 2, 3 DC in the next st; Rep from * until the last 4 sts. Skip 2, DC last 2 sts.

Row 5: CH3, DC in next st, skip next st, 3 DC in next st, *skip 2, 3 DC in the next st; Rep from * until the last 3 sts. Skip next st, DC the last 2 sts.

Repeat **Rows 4-5**, until the length measures approx. 48cm (19"), and the hook is on the left side when right side is facing up.

Next Row: CH1, SC all sts until the end of the row.

Repeat **Rows 2-3**, once.

Finishing: Fasten off, and weave in loose ends. With needle, sew 5 buttons on each opposite corner, adjacent to the button holes. Position buttons accordingly to align underneath the button holes.

Do up buttons in different ways to create different designs! Wear as a shawl, scarf, top or vest. It is extremely versatile!
