AS SEEN ON THE RUNWAYS - FUR/PRINT SCARF



WHAT YOU NEED: 30cm x 150cm fur 30cm x 150cm printed fabric



Cut 2 pieces of the print fabric 25x75cm (10x30")



Stitch the 2 pieces together using a 1cm seam leaving an opening in the center as shown



Fold stitched pieces in half lengthwise and mark a curved line on the cut edge as shown



Cut along marked line through all the layers to create a curve on both ends



Place the print fabric on the WRONG side of the fur, pin and cut fur fabric to the same size as the print fabric. When cutting the fur try to cut the backing only and not the fur pile.



Remove pins.
Stitch 1cm around fur edges pushing the fur lengths towards the center of the fabric (*see NOTE below)



Place RIGHT side of the fur and print together and pin



Stitch around the entire scarf 1cm from the edge



Insert your hand into the opening on the print side and turn RIGHT sides out



Hand stitch opening closed
