Easy Spider Headband A quick, fun craft for kids & adults!

MATERALS Wave Glitter Tulle in Purple and Lime 4cm DIY Headband

10cm Black Yarn Pompom Beige Faux Leather Lacing 15mm Moving Eyes



You will also need scissors, glue (a hot glue gun or white glue) and a needle and thread.



Check to find the bottom of the pompom, where there is an elastic loop. Make sure to keep this end down, as we'll need the loop later.

Glue the moving eyes on.

Cut 8 x5cm pieces of the faux leather lacing and glue them as well. Make sure to glue the "legs" securely into the interior of the pompom.



When you've sewn through the width of the tulle, pull the excess end of the thread and the tulle will gather into a bow. Glue this to the headband.

Make a loose running stitch through 2 pieces of the wave glitter tulle. Make sure to leave excess thread on one side.

Now take the elastic loop on the bottom of your pompom spider and push the headband through it until the spider sits on top of the bow.
